

Asian Future Leaders Scholarship Program 2024

Bai Xian Asia Institute Limited (BXAI) is inviting applications for “Asian Future Leaders Scholarship Program” (AFLSP).

Coverage of the Scholarship

Up to 10 students will be awarded an amount of maximum US\$25,000 per year each. Each scholarship is tenable for up to two years.

Eligibility

The candidates must:

- be registered full-time CUHK students during the entire Scholarship period;
- be non-local students whose nationality is from an Asian country or region;
- be currently in their second or third-year undergraduate studies;
- major in **Global Studies Programme** OR any programme under **Faculty of Business Administration** or **Faculty of Engineering**; and
- have achieved a Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 up to Term 1 of 2023/24*.

* *Though the academic results for Term 1 of 2023/24 are not available yet, interested students should still submit their scholarship applications if they would like to be considered.*

Scholars must commit to participating in the BXAI Summer Program, and partake in the Enrichment Program as arranged and required by CUHK.
